- **Please Note—School will be closed** next Friday, Nov. 9. Both school offices will also be closed.
- **Parent Teacher Conferences** will be held next Tuesday, Nov. 6, and Thursday, Nov. 8, from 5:00-8:00 pm. All conferences are held at the elementary building. All appointments are scheduled on a first come, first served basis.
 - **Elementary/IPOD**—We ask all parents of PreK-6th grade children schedule a conference with their child's homeroom teacher. Those who do not sign up will be put into the schedule where there are openings. Conferences will be 12 minutes in length. All elementary conferences will be held in your child's classroom. IPOD teachers will be assigned a room to hold conferences in at the elementary building. *Parents of IPOD Students (5th/6th grade) should sign up with their child's homeroom teacher only. Written notes regarding classroom information, student progress and other observations will be provided for all students by the IPOD teachers.
 - **7th/8th grade conferences** will be 6 minutes in length and also will be held in the elementary building. We ask that 7th-8th grade parents schedule a conference with their child's teacher(s). We ask that you do not schedule to see more than three MS teachers. *Mrs. Lautenbach will be providing written notes to Mr. DeYoung regarding her 7th grade LA1 students, no separate conference with Mrs. Lautenbach will be necessary.

TERRACYCLE

Please be aware that we DO NOT accept candy wrappers. At this time of year we always start receiving lots of them and TerraCycle will NOT accept them. Please do not send in any candy wrappers (either individual wrappers or from bags of candy).

Are you having a Halloween party or a get together? We want your solo cups! If it says #6 on the bottom, we can TerraCycle them. There is a large bonus available for every shipment of #6 cups we send in. Collect up your cups after your party (give them a quick rinse if needed) and send them into school to make some money for LCS!

TerraCycle is such an easy fundraiser! It is a way we can make money without buying something extra or selling something. You don't need to make special deliveries or collect money. Get your hands on a TerraCycle list. Talk to your family and grab a plastic bag to collect in. Put it next to your trash can or recycle bin and instead of throwing away your empty toothpaste tube, shampoo bottle or granola bar wrapper, put it in your TerraCycle bag. So easy! We have about 230 families at Legacy. TerraCycle pays about \$0.02 per item collected. If every family collected 30 items a week for a year we could raise over \$7,000.00 for Legacy from trash! ($\$0.02 \times 30 \times 52 \text{ weeks} \times 230 \text{ families} = \$7,000.00+$) Once you start TerraCycling, you will be amazed at how fast your TC bag fills up!
