



LCS Extended Care Frequently Asked Questions

❖ What is extended care?

Extended care is a before and after school program offered to children enrolled in LCS preschool or young 5's classes and is designed to support family child-care needs. Extended care runs during the school year and is only offered when school is in session.

❖ What is the cost of extended care?

- Before school care (7:45-8:45am) - \$5 / day
- After school care (11:15am-3:00pm) or before school care (8:45am-12:00pm) if your child is an afternoon preschool student - \$15 / day
- Full day (7:45am-3:00pm) if your child is in preschool and you need child care on days your child isn't in a preschool class - \$25 / day

❖ Do I need to sign up for the full year?

Yes, we do require that families commit to a schedule for the full school year. If there are openings in the program, student drop-ins may be allowed, as long as the child is registered in the program and has paid the registration fee.

❖ Is LCS Extended Care licensed with the State of Michigan?

Yes. A copy of the LCS licensing notebook can be found in the elementary school office.

❖ What certification does the extended care director have?

Our program director has all the necessary state certifications as required by the State of Michigan.

❖ What is the staff/student ratio in extended care?

1:10 ratio

❖ Are lunches and snacks provided by the school?

No. Students will need to provide their own snacks and lunch from home.

❖ What will my child do in extended care?

All of the children will experience a variety of activities during extended care, including free play, stories, coloring, rest time and outdoor play.
